

ADMISSIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Dual credential program – Eton College Canada and Vancouver Island University (SD 47 Cohort)

Admission Requirements

Applicants must meet all minimum admissions requirements to be considered for admission. The minimum admissions requirements cannot be waived by educational institutions or by the applicant under any circumstance.

1. General Admission Requirements:

- Completed BC High School graduation (or equivalent in another school system) OR
- 19 years of age or older – must successfully complete a Placement Assessment
- Medical insurance coverage
- Flight Attendant Preparation Program requires Flight Attendant Preparation Entrance Agreement

2. Demonstrate English Proficiency* with one of the following:

- BC High School English 12 – minimum C (60-66%)
- BC High School Communications 12 – minimum C+ (67-72%)
- TOEFL PBT score 500, or CBT 173, or iBT 61
- IELTS minimum overall band test score 6

* Note: A Placement Assessment will be required if the candidate does not meet minimum English Proficiency requirements as above.

Application Procedure

3. Together with your application form, please submit the following:

- A copy of your passport
- A certified copy of your highest diploma/degree attained (if unavailable, please submit on a later date) copy of your official school transcript and examination results in relation to the above mentioned diploma/degree
- TOEFL or IELTS Score Report

4. The application for admission must be accompanied by a **non-refundable application fee of CAD \$150**.

5. Upon receipt of all your documents and your application fee, the school will make a decision as to whether your application is approved or not. If approved, you will receive a **Conditional Letter of Acceptance**. (This document cannot be used for study permit application.)
6. Upon receipt of our Conditional Letter of Acceptance, please pay School District 47 (see information above for payment) a CAD\$10,000 minimum tuition deposit. Your tuition deposit indicates your commitment to your education for the purpose of applying for a study permit.
7. Upon the receipt of your tuition deposit, you will be issued an Official Letter of Acceptance. With this Official Letter of Acceptance and all other supporting documents, you can now proceed to the nearest Canadian Embassy/Consulate in your country to apply for your study permit.
8. The balance of the tuition fees and all other fees become payable as soon as you receive your study permit. The deadline for full payment of all fees is: July 31st, 2016.
9. If your study permit is declined, an amount of **CAD\$400**, plus the non-refundable application fee of **CAD\$150**, will be retained as a service fee. The balance amount you paid is refundable.

Customer service experience:

I understand that customer service experience is a very important qualification because a flight attendant's job includes working in front of the public on a daily basis. From greeting, serving, and assisting passengers to making announcements, a flight attendant represents the airline company and needs to project a positive image at all times.

Education:

I understand that airlines may require me to produce a High School Diploma and may also give preferences to applicants with higher education. A bachelor's degree or at least a year in college may increase my chances of getting hired.

Working condition: (excerpt from Work Futures BC)

The work can be strenuous and tiring. These employees often work through several time zones and may experience jet lag. On flights that encounter strong air turbulence, serving meals and drinks can be difficult. Short flights on which meals are served require fast service and good timing. Attendants are on their feet for much of the flight and must remain composed, prompt and polite, no matter how tired they are or how demanding the passengers may be. Working in a moving airplane also makes them susceptible to injury.

Attitude, Personality and Skills:

I understand that the following are essential traits and skills to increase my prospect of employment with airlines: positive attitude, people oriented, excellent team player, pleasant and professional conduct, excellent speech and polished grooming. I also understand that demonstrating these essential traits and skills in class is necessary as it is practice for the working world! I will use this opportunity to polish a professional appearance and attitude.

Medical conditions:

I do not suffer from any known medical condition that may preclude my employment opportunities as a Flight Attendant (i.e. heart condition, respiratory condition, psychological condition, or any other chronic condition that may prevent my employment with an airline company as a flight attendant).

Field trips:

I understand that field trips to certain industry facilities such as Airlines/Airport visit are subject to approval by the hosts/ security clearance etc., and may not be possible to arrange during the course of my program. I also understand that some of these visits may involve a small charge imposed by the hosts and the cost will be borne by me.
